Alternatively Fuelled Vehicle Workshop

Workshop Overview

This mandatory 5-hour course enables Category B licence holders to legally drive AFV goods vehicles up to 4.25 tonnes, accommodating the extra weight of batteries.

The course targets businesses aiming to reduce their carbon footprint by transitioning to alternative fuels like electric, hydrogen, natural gas, or biogas.

Delivered by registered trainers (NRI or NVDIR), it provides a certificate of completion, allowing legal operation of AFVs.

On-road coaching and vehicle familiarisation available as an additional programme.
